Sam Pearson presented to Council historical information gathered by the Flood Impact Task Force regarding the Community Rating System, Floods, Biggert Waters Act, Flood Insurance, and the Homeowners Insurance Affordability Act. It was suggested the Local policy needs direction for prioritizing projects, education about flood insurance, policy on reassessment, resiliency planning, synthesis of concerns and State planning board outreach. Should we visit DC to bring more attention to this topic as SEDA-COG has? Should the Borough have a more proactive Certified Floodplain Manager or a Planner? These questions will be brought to the March Work Session for further discussions.
