

MAYORAL PROCLAMATION

"Recognizing Constitution Week and Citizenship Day" Proclamation September 17-23, 2025

WHEREAS, September 17, 1787, marks the signing of the United States Constitution, the foundational document that established the principles of liberty, justice, and government by the people; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has designated September 17 as Constitution Day and September 17–23 as Constitution Week, to celebrate the enduring strength of our democracy and the framework of rights and responsibilities that guide our nation; and

WHEREAS, Citizenship Day, observed on September 17, recognizes all who, through birth or naturalization, are citizens of the United States, and honors the journeys of those who have chosen to embrace the rights and duties of American citizenship; and

WHEREAS, Constitution Week provides an opportunity for all residents to reflect on the privileges of citizenship, to reaffirm their commitment to civic responsibility, and to honor the diverse contributions of citizens who strengthen our communities and democracy; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lewisburg values civic engagement, inclusivity, and the shared responsibility of building a vibrant community where all residents can thrive;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kendy Alvarez, Mayor of the Borough of Lewisburg, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17–23, 2025, as Constitution Week and Citizenship Day in the Borough of Lewisburg, and encourage all residents to celebrate the ideals of freedom and democracy, to participate fully in civic life, and to welcome and support our fellow citizens, both native-born and naturalized.
