Hufnagle Park Construction on Schedule

As we make our way into Summer, the much-anticipated renovations of Hufnagle Park are on schedule. The design of the renovated park was formulated around the community's needs that are outlined in the 2019 Bull Run Greenway Master Plan.

The Plan lists these needs as:

- Regional outdoor entertainment venue – stage w/ lighting & electric, amphitheater with double seating capacity, lawn seating
- Active and passive recreational spaces, green spaces
- Naturalized landscaping and use of native plants, year-round color, low maintenance, shade trees
- Public Transportation drop-off location, physical access from Market Street, safety, visual access
- ADA accessibility, walkable connection
- Floodplain expansion, flood resilient community

All these items are coming to fruition as the project progresses. The anticipated completion date is December 2023. Work on Market Street will begin on July 17th and will require a slight adjustment to traffic for approximately five weeks. Please use caution in this work zone area. The public restrooms are currently open but there will be a week when these restrooms will be closed and a port-a-potty will take their place. The Borough of Lewisburg thanks you for your patience during this construction project.

Leaf Collection

Fall leaf collection will begin on September 18, 2023 and run through November 24. Leaf collection follows the street cleaning schedule. Leaves must be placed in the parking spaces along the curbs prior to 6:30 am on the collection date. Residents are reminded that vehicles illegally parked on No Parking days will be towed during leaf collection. Towing will begin on September 25. Brush Pile

The brush pile is provided for Borough residents and Borough property owners (while working on their Borough properties) to dispose of leaves, branches, and other brush materials. It is posted for use by Borough residents only. Residents and Borough property owners (while working on their Borough properties) are able to use the brush pile at no cost, with proper identification. If you have a contractor working on your property and they wish to dispose of your materials at our brush pile, please come into the Borough Office to get a preapproval pass, which will allow them to dispose of approved materials at the brush pile. Non-residents may use the brush pile after purchasing a pass in the Borough Office. ***Please note that the Borough does not accept grass clippings and weeds at the brush pile.**

Shade Tree Trimming

The Borough would like to remind all property owners that shade trees are to be trimmed by the property owners. Shade trees must have a minimum clearance of fifteen feet above any public highway and at least nine feet above all sidewalks. They must also be trimmed as to not interfere with streetlights, street signs, or traffic control devices. Additionally, it is the property owner's responsibility to remove any dead or diseased branches that may create a hazard to person or properties in or along public streets. All trimming must be done according to the American National Standards Institute ANSI A3000 Pruning Standards.

Brush Pile & Recycling Center Hours

The Brush Pile and Recycling Center are open every Wednesday from 8 AM to 4 PM and every Saturday from 8 AM until noon. Both are located in the Wolfe Field Complex.
