Brush Pile

The brush pile is available to Borough residents and Borough property owners who are working on their properties. Approved materials, including leaves, branches, and other woody brush materials, may be disposed of at no cost with proper identification. Please



note that grass clippings and weeds are **not accepted** at the brush pile.

If you hire a contractor to perform work on your property and would like them to use the brush pile, please visit the Borough office to obtain a pre-approved pass. This pass will allow the contractor to dispose of approved materials on your behalf. Non-residents may also use the brush pile by **purchasing** a pass at the Borough office (\$10 for a car/SUV or minivan; \$15 for a van or pick-up truck; \$25 for a pull-behind trailer; and \$50 for a dump truck or box truck). This is a one-time use pass—multiple trips require multiple passes.

Compost

A compost site has been created at the recycling center! Acceptable materials include weeds, grass, ornamental grasses, and other greens. Items not accepted: food items and root balls. You can take

your brush and composting materials to the recycling center located at Wolfe Field on Wednesdays, 8am—4pm & Saturdays, 8am—12noon.

These fixtures are a cherished part of our community's historic charm, and attaching items to them can damage the paint and compromise their appearance over time. When parking downtown, don't forget your change! The yellow parking tickets are issued Mondays—Saturdays, 9:00am—5:00pm, as it is posted on the meters. We ask that you treat the parking meters the same as the tri-globe light posts: no tape, stickers, or zip ties (see article above, top right).



Lewisburg Borough Refuse Collection is between the hours of 6:30am – 3:00pm

The Lewisburg Borough Refuse Department would like to remind all residents, property owners, and businesses that collection of your weekly refuse could occur anytime between 6:30 am – 3:00 pm on your scheduled refuse pick-up day. While you may be used to seeing our garbage trucks on your street during a certain time of day, please note that schedules are subject to change due to equipment maintenance, or to make routes more efficient for our Refuse Crew.

It is recommended that you have your bagged refuse in your water-tight container at the curbside/roadside **the night before** your scheduled day of collection if you're not able to have it out before 6:30 am that day. Our crews are unable to return for any refuse that was set out late.



Additionally, our Refuse Crew kindly asks that, if possible, you **mark your garbage cans with your house number**. This simple step helps identify containers in windy weather or if they become displaced. Paint or number stickers are typically available at local hardware stores.

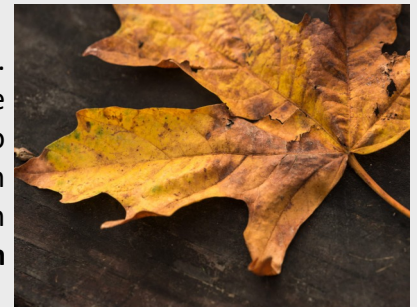

Fall Leaf Collection

Leaf collection will begin on October 12, 2026 and run through December 4. Leaf collection follows the street cleaning schedule which is available online. Leaves must be placed in the parking spaces along the curbs prior to 6:30 am on the collection day. No leaves will be collected in alleyways or on the sidewalk. Residents are reminded that vehicles illegally parked on **No Parking** days will be towed during this time. **Towing will begin on October 26, 2026.**
